### **What is the Peril of Flood Act??**

- Section 163.3178(2)(f)1, Florida Statutes
- It was passed to help municipalities be better prepared for flooding caused by natural factors like sea level rise and storm surges
- It specifies new requirements for the Coastal Management Element of the Town's Comprehensive Plan

### **Why are we having a meeting?**

- We are meeting to talk about how Lauderdale-by-the-Sea will comply with the Peril of Flood Act.
- We'll discuss sea level rise and storm surge as it pertains to the Town, and how to reduce flood risk.
- We'll listen to your experiences with flooding, particularly in Lauderdale-By-The-Sea

Staff from the South Florida Regional Planning Council will be leading the discussion, and will also describe a project the Planning Council is doing with the Town to assist us in updating the Coastal Management element of our Comprehensive Plan.
