"**Relay For Life**" is the nationwide signature event for the American Cancer Society and the single largest non-profit event in the world. In 2010, Relays were held in over 5,000 communities, which included 23 countries throughout the world raising over \$374,000,000. It is about a **community** that takes up the fight against cancer in a way that is a celebratory, fun and a unique experience. Unlike any other walk or fundraising event, Relay For Life is the overnight experience of a lifetime!!

Teams of people from your community come together at a local school or park to walk, run, stroll and roll against cancer, keeping at least one member of the team walking, representing the team at all times during the event. Teams are formed from groups of families and friends, co-workers, and civic or religious organizations. Enjoy around-the-clock family-oriented fun and entertainment in your own neighborhood, while raising funds and awareness in the battle against cancer.

Honoring Survivors!

In each community, cancer survivors, young and old, are invited to participate in the Opening Ceremony of the Relay For Life by walking the **Survivor's Victory Lap** around the track. This symbolic tribute honors cancer survivors and celebrates life! If you are or know a cancer survivor and would like them to be honored, please let us know.

Candlelight/Luminaria Ceremony!

The candlelight ceremony begins after dark at Relay For Life. Light a candle, or have one lit in your absence, as a memorial to a loved one who has lost their battle to cancer or in honor of a cancer survivor. The heartfelt love and caring shared by friends and family during this ceremony is moving and healing.

Fun!

On Relay night, participants pitch tents and decorate in the theme their team has chosen and everybody is "ready to Relay". Throughout the evening and into the next day, participants enjoy entertainment, games, music, great food, camaraderie and tons of FUN.
